## **Children's Ministry COVID-19 Response at the Tabernacle**

- 1) We are taking precautions to minimize the risk of Covid -19 by cleaning the facility and sharing with you ways to prevent the spread and how you can help.
- 2) **All children and volunteers will be required to sign a Statement of Waiver of Liability and Assumption of Risk. If you are not comfortable signing the agreement, then we will ask you to wait before attending or volunteering in class.**
- 3) **If you have been directly exposed to Covid-19 we ask you to stay out 14 days before returning.**
- 4) **If a class has been directly exposed to Covid-19 that class will be shut down for 14 days.**
- 5) Visible reminders of Covid -19 symptoms are displayed on the doors and hallway tables. Please do not enter if you are experiencing any symptoms.
- 6) Temperatures will be taken of each volunteer and child before entering a classroom. Anyone with a temperature of 100.3 or above will not be allowed to stay in class. Should a child become sick they will be removed from the class immediately. TERPS (EMT)
- 7) will be notified and parents.
- 8) Hand Sanitizer is provided in the halls and classrooms. Please use when entering.
- 9) Chairs have been arranged in the room to allow for increased social distancing.
- 10) Every child will have their name placed on a pencil bag to put their crayons or pencils in.
- 11) Cleaning schedules and disinfectant measures are in place. Routine cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfecting of surfaces and objects that are frequently touched such as doorknobs, light switches, tables, and chairs.
- 12) Food and parties in all classes will not be allowed until further notice.
- 13) The church will not be providing any snacks during Sunday School.
  - a. When Junior Church and childcare for Nursery thru K-5 during the 10:15 Worship Service starts back the church will provide a snack. Gloves will be provided to use during that time and children will wash or sanitize hands before and after eating.
- 14) Volunteers will wear mask or face covering when physical distancing cannot be maintained.
- 15) If Volunteers do not have a mask or face covering the church will provide one for them.
- 16) Hugging a child is unavoidable for teachers so we will give hugs on the shoulder from the side.
- 17) We are praying for everyone in the ministry and doing our best to keep everyone safe.
