

Mission

Admission Policy

Our purpose is to provide a Christ-centered environment that will encourage every child to grow in the Lord. For the school to accomplish its purpose to provide a Christ-centered environment, *it is essential that each student and at least one parent regularly attend church services that are comparable to our Statement of Faith.* We want to be a strength and encouragement to each child's family and help them to grow to maturity in Christ.

Once we receive your child's Application for Admission, along with the registration fee, a temporary spot will be held for your child and if necessary, an interview will be set up by the teacher. Upon review by the TLC Board, applicants will then be notified of their admission status. Submitting an application and payment of the registration fee does not guarantee acceptance. All applications are subject to approval by the TLC Board. If your child is not accepted, your registration fee will be refunded.
